SUMMARY OF INFORMATION.-

SUBJECT: Yugoslav Military Activity in Zone "B".

From a reliable informant coming from Yugoslavia the following was reported to this Agent:

1. On 14 Nov 1946, two artillery batteries, cal. 60 mm. arrived in Postumia from Ljubljana by rail. Other smaller units were on the same train. The artillery batteries were then immediately dispatched to the border Zone "A" and "B".
2. Ending on 16 November 1946, many buildings in Fiume were requisitioned by the Yugoslav Army authorities to house the troops constantly arriving from Yugoslavia proper. Some of the buildings requisitioned are: "Café Centrale", "Café Pancera", and the "Bonavia". The majority of the troops are armed with automatic arms. Numerous field kitchens which arrived in Fiume by train were dispatched to units located in Zone "B".
